This event will now take place at American Royal Palace in Phoenix, AZ on Saturday, July 27, 2024. As disclosed during the May 15th Commission Meeting, due to a potential conflict of interest, the Executive Director has recused himself from this event and this event will be administered by Assistant Director JuanCarlos Estrada.

Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) § 38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the general public that Commission members of the Arizona Boxing and MMA Commission may be in attendance at the aforementioned events. As such, a quorum of the Commission may be present. 2. Legislative Update – SB1679 Passed a Final Read in the State Senate on Wednesday, June 12, 2024 and has been transmitted to the Governor’s Office.
