The Commission Chair reserves the right to change the order of items on the agenda, except for public hearings set for a specific time. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02, the Racing Commission ensures that all public meeting notices are posted electronically on the <u>Racing Commission webpage</u>. Additionally, a physical copy of public meeting notices will be posted on the exterior bulletin board at the entrance of the <u>Arizona</u> <u>Department of Gaming, 100 N. 15th Ave. #200, Phoenix, AZ 85007</u>

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3), the Commission may vote to go into Executive Session for the purpose of obtaining legal advice from its attorney on any matter listed on the agenda. Any such Executive Session will not be open to the public. The Commission may utilize a private video conference or tele-conference for an Executive Session.
