A. Call to Order of the 668th Regular Arizona Racing Commission Meeting of March 14, 2019, at 10:03 AM

At the start of the meeting, Chair Goreé announced Item B.1 was not going to be necessary, as there are no updates. The Commission will start with Items C.2 and C.3. then jump to the Information Reports then move back to Items C.1 and C.4.

C. Action Items

1. TP Racing, L.L.L.P. Consideration of Final Three-Year Commercial Permit Renewal (FY 2019, 2020 & 2021)

The Commission at 11:45 AM heard this matter.

Chair Goreé advised the Commission that he has received a request to table this matter until a couple of items are addressed. As soon as the item is resolved, he will request that a special meeting be called to address this item. Commissioner Coolidge second. Motion carried. (Ayes: Coolidge, Goreé, Lawless, McClintock.)

Commission Secretary advised the Commission this matter requires a 15-Day Notice of Hearing to be posted. The earliest date for a meeting is April 4, 2019. Chair Goreé said he would let the Department know later this evening if that is sufficient time to address the issue.

The Commission moved to Item D – Information Reports at 11:47 AM.

2. Xpressbet, LLC's Consideration for ADW Permit

Greg Stiles addressed the Commission.

Dave Auther, Arizona Downs, addressed the Commission. Arizona Downs does not object to the permit, but wants to point out the issues with Xpressbet as it relates to Monarch and Item C.4.

Commissioner McClintock moved to approve the Xpressbet, LLC's ADW Permit application. Vice Chair Lawless second. Motion carried. (Ayes: Goreé, Lawless, McClintock; Nays: Coolidge.)

Commissioner McClintock moved to approve the Arizona American Italian Club as an Arizona Downs OTB. Vice Chair Lawless second. Motion carried. (Ayes: Coolidge, Goreé, Lawless, McClintock.)

4. Proposed Rule Change of A.A.C. R19-2-419(K)

Chair Goreé advised each party would have 10 minutes to address the Commission on its brief and five minutes for any rebuttals. Dave Auther filed a motion, and the Commission granted, an Order re: Motion to Associate Counsel Pro Hac Vice for Douglas L. McSwain to appear before the Commission on behalf of Arizona Downs in this matter.

Vice Chair Lawless asked if Scott Daruty from Monarch was in attendance and, if he was, to please address the Commission.

Scott Daruty, President of Monarch Content Managing, LLC, addressed the Commission advising he was present as an observer and had no formal remarks prepared for this meeting. He answered questions from the Commission regarding Monarch's position and simulcasting signals to two OTB networks.

Commissioner Coolidge moved, that in the interest of resolving the issue as quickly as possible, the Commission table this vote until next month hoping all parties come to an amicable resolution before the horsemen resolve their issue. He implored Turf Paradise to continue to come to the table in good faith to resolve the issues to help Arizona racing move forward. Urged partners like Monarch and other to resolve issues with other organizations present at the meeting and he hoped Monarch would take a minute to talk to the Arizona Downs and Rillito participants to see if we could move forward as quickly as possible. If the issue isn't resolved by the next meeting, the Commission will be watching the proceedings happening up until then, and the Commission will make sure that it votes next month, one way or another, on passing a proposed rule and/or reaching out to the Governor's office for support to pass such a rule. Chair Goreé second and put everyone on notice that he expects everyone at the March 15th meeting to be working in good faith to get this resolved, otherwise, there will be a rule coming. Motion carried. (Ayes: Coolidge, Goreé, Lawless, McClintock.)

Chair Goreé asked to take a five-minute recess.

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Dave Auther, Arizona Downs, addressed the Commission and volunteered to prepare and send a letter to the Governor that indicates what the Commission is considering with respect to the rule so that that can get taken care of simultaneously while the matter in a holding pattern. He can present it to the Commission for review and approval and the Commission will submit it to the Governor.

Chair Goreé stated his preference is to direct the Division to work with the Attorney General's office and, possibly, get a brief on this issue.

Aiden Fleming, Gaming Legislative Liaison, addressed the Commission, advising the letter asking for an exception to the moratorium on rule making should come from the Agency and he will prepare one and get it to the Commission.

Assistant Attorney General Reh advised she could get an answer quickly on whether or not the Attorney General's office will be able to prepare a brief on the matter for the Commission.

Chair Goreé asked that there be a couple of spokespersons for this item since a dozen people signed up to speak. It was agreed that two people would speak.
