- 1. Discussion and Possible Action on the 2019 Breeders' Cup Simulcast Horse Racing Import Signals
  - A. Arizona Downs BCL Agreement

Commissioner Coolidge moved to approve the Arizona Downs Breeders' Cup signal for the November 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> race dates condition on the fact that the simulcast signal is provided to all the permittees and all of their OTBs for the duration of the Breeders' Cup. If at any time the signal is not provided, no permittee nor any OTB shall be approved to take bets on the Breeders' Cup simulcast signal. Chair Goreé second. Motion carried. B. Turf Paradise <u>BCL</u> <u>Agreement</u> <u>Monarch Content (Breeders' Cup)</u>

Commissioner Coolidge moved to approve the Turf Paradise Breeders' Cup signal for the November 1st and 2nd race dates condition on the fact that the simulcast signal is provided to all the permittees and all of their OTBs for the duration of the Breeders' Cup. If at any time the signal is not provided, no permittee nor any OTB shall be approved to take bets on the Breeders' Cup simulcast signal. Chair Goreé second. Motion carried. (Ayes: Coolidge, Goreé, Lawless, McClintock.)

Chair Goreé asked the Division to look into why the signal providers are not licensed and to provide a report to the Commission for the December 12, 2019 meeting. He believes they should be licensed.
