## **Arizona Department of Gaming Releases August Sports Betting Figures**

PHOENIX – Bettors in Arizona wagered over \$358 million on sports in August of 2023, according to a new report by the Arizona Department of Gaming. This represents an 11% increase when compared to July of this year.
