



At this time, some Arizona casinos are temporarily closed. It is within the authority of each sovereign Tribal partner to determine appropriate measures, including reopen dates. The Arizona Department of Gaming (ADG) continues to share the latest guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Arizona Department of Health Services to assist Tribal partners in making decisions regarding their response to COVID-19. ADG regulators are in contact with respective Tribal gaming offices and are providing technical assistance and guidance based on their decision to suspend casino operations as a precautionary measure. ADG will continue to be a resource and share information and expertise to all of its Arizona gaming industry partners as the situation evolves.
