Arizona Department of Gaming Releases December Sports Betting Figures

PHOENIX – Bettors in Arizona wagered over \$693.3 million on sports in December of 2023, according to a new report by the Arizona Department of Gaming. This represents an approximate 21% increase when compared to December of 2022.
