Governor Ducey Announces Acting Director of Racing

(PHOENIX) Governor Doug Ducey today appointed Rudy Casillas to serve as acting director of the Arizona Department of Racing.

"A law enforcement veteran of more than 40 years, Rudy brings extensive and valuable knowledge to the Department of Racing," said Governor Ducey. Mr. Casillas previously was with the Phoenix Police Department, where he began his law enforcement career in 1974.
