Arizona Department of Gaming Releases August Sports Betting Figures

PHOENIX – Bettors in Arizona wagered approximately \$497 million on sports in August of 2024, according to a new report by the Arizona Department of Gaming. This represents an approximate 38.4% increase when compared to August of 2023.
