Arizona Department of Gaming Releases December Sports Betting Figures

PHOENIX — Bettors in Arizona wagered approximately \$849 million on sports in December of 2024, according to a new report by the Arizona Department of Gaming. This represents an approximate 22.5% increase when compared to December of 2023.
