Arizona Department of Gaming Releases July Sports Betting Figures

PHOENIX — Bettors in Arizona wagered approximately \$410 million on sports in July of 2024, according to a new report by the Arizona Department of Gaming. This represents an approximate 26.9% increase when compared to July of 2023.
