Arizona Department of Gaming Releases November Sports Betting Figures

PHOENIX – Bettors in Arizona wagered approximately \$898 million on sports in November of 2024, according to a new report by the Arizona Department of Gaming. This represents an approximate 26% increase when compared to November of 2023.
