

2023 Event Wagering Operator Allocation Period

On June 30, 2023, ADG <u>announced</u> that it will begin <u>accepting applications</u> for available event wagering licenses, which include one license reserved for Arizona Tribes and two licenses reserved for Arizona Sports Franchises. Announcement of Event Wagering Operator License
