Arizona Department of Gaming Releases June Sports Betting Figures

PHOENIX — Bettors in Arizona wagered approximately \$454 million on sports in June of 2024, according to a new report by the Arizona Department of Gaming. This represents an approximate 15.5% increase when compared to June of 2023.
