## **Arizona Department of Gaming Releases November Sports Betting Figures**

PHOENIX – Bettors in Arizona wagered over \$713.5 million on sports in November of 2023, according to a new report by the Arizona Department of Gaming. This represents an approximate 15.7% increase when compared to November of 2022.
