Arizona Department of Gaming Releases September Sports Betting Figures

PHOENIX – Bettors in Arizona wagered over \$610 million on sports in September of 2023, according to a new report by the Arizona Department of Gaming. This represents a 13.5% increase when compared to September of last year.
