

FANTASY SPORTS GUIDANCE

SUBMISSIONS

System & Function Certification – Responsible parties may submit their written verification regarding the design requirements (R19-4-211.A), geofence requirements (R19-4-211.B), and a confirmation of proper calculation of contest entry fees and payouts (R19-4-211.C) relating to their fantasy sports contest platform. This information may be submitted to Hal Wafer at hwafer@azgaming.gov

Server Location – The Department will accept notification from responsible parties as to the physical location of each server that accepts fantasy sports contest entries (R19-4-209). This notification may be submitted to Hal Wafer at hwafer@azgaming.gov

Internal Controls – The Department will accept internal controls submissions as per R19-4-207. The Department requests that the ICs be submitted in a single complete set. These ICs should be submitted to Hal Wafer via hwafer@azgaming.gov

House Rules – The Department will accept house rules submissions as per R19-4-215. The Department requests that the house rules be submitted in a single complete set. These policies should be submitted to Hal Wafer via hwafer@azgaming.gov

Fantasy Sports Contest Catalogue – The Department will accept the catalogue from responsible parties of their fantasy sports contests. The Department requests that the catalogue be submitted in an excel file or other electronic searchable file. The Department will use these submitted files to publish the list of authorized fantasy sports contests on its website. Fantasy sports contests should follow the Statutory language in A.R.S. § 5-1201(6). The catalogue should be submitted to Hal Wafer via hwafer@azgaming.gov

Account Creation – The Department has set August 28, 2021 at 12:01am (AZ), as the date responsible parties may begin player account creation and may go-live.

Fantasy Sports Contest Adjusted Revenue & Privilege Fees – The Department will be reaching out to you with instructions and the applicable forms for the monthly reporting of FSCAR and payment of the privilege fees as per R19-4-208. Geofencing – The Department is requesting the name and contact information for the geofence provider of each operator. This information should be submitted to Hal Wafer via hwafer@azgaming.gov

Marketing – Licensed Operators, Management Companies, & Suppliers may begin marketing on August 28, 2021 at 12:01am. Marketing does not need to be submitted to the Department but must follow the standards in R19-4-206.

Terms and Conditions – The Department would like to request a copy of (or access to) the player account terms and conditions (R19-4-217). The terms and conditions should be specific to the requirements of the State of Arizona (where applicable). This information should be submitted to Hal Wafer via hwafer@azgaming.gov

Promotions and Bonuses – The Department requests to see the rules for the initial promotions and bonuses offered directly to patrons in Arizona. This information should be submitted to Hal Wafer via hwafer@azgaming.gov
